Position Overview

The Media Specialist will facilitate audio recording session on July 20 at Paper Mill Studios, work remotely to prepare the audio clips and create the visual slide package in, attend rehearsals at the school the week of August 4, and participate in the performances on August 7 and 8 at 10:00am.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

Audio Recording Captures/Visual Aid creation

- The Media Specialist will record young actors' voices, edit the audio clips and prepare them for use during the performance, organize a digital media folder for this purpose,
- Collaborate with the Director on the images and concepts to be displayed on show slides, create
 the slide package, and run sound and AV delivery during the performance days of August 7 and
 8.
- Support students and faculty regarding all aspects of sound and image technology,
- Liaise with school administration on equipment and power needs to execute the performance
- Notify Paper Mill administration of existing equipment inventory, and any supplemental equipment needed.

Team Collaboration

- Attend HR orientation and collaborate with Project Director/Teaching Artist to align instructional plans supported by AV technologies
- Communicate regularly with Program Director/Teaching Artist regarding equipment needs and scheduling
- Uphold a positive, inclusive, and respectful learning environment for all students

Paper Mill Playhouse's "Theater for Everyone: Lend Your Voice" summer residency at the Pillar School in Livingston New Jersey, requires a Media Specialist to support the recording of audio tracks and the creation of a visual PowerPoint slide package to support a student production of Beauty and the Beast on August 7 and 8, 2025. The performances will be live on stage at the Pillar School.

Some students in the performance company are nonverbal and the Media Specialists will support the Theater Director/Teaching Artist in recording the spoken lines for students appearing in the show. Performers will utilize an audio clip of their script parts with the assistance of a trigger button and their 1:1 aide.

During the performance, a PowerPoint presentation is displayed above the stage area to assist with communication and comprehension of the story of a show.
